Programme Approval Agreement

A Programme Approval Agreement (PAA) is a high level Quality Assurance Agreement with specific providers. The PAA enables agreed Organisations to evaluate and approve their own programmes in accordance with a set of agreed processes, procedures and criteria. It enables holders to control their own processes in relation to programme development, evaluation and approval, and to be more responsive to demands for new programmes from their own centres. Some agreements cover one organisation e.g. FAS, Fáilte Ireland, National Learning Network or some are cluster agreements covering a number of providers e.g. Leinster Cluster of VEC covering five VEC's in the Leinster area.

Shared Programme

A shared programme is developed for sharing by a number of providers. QBS allows a provider to create a Shared programme and stipulate access by either Provider type e.g. Community Voluntary/Private Provider or by named provider.

The outline process is as follows:

Step 1 – The Programme is developed by Provider A

Step 2 – Provider A uploads a validation application to the QBS with full programme descriptor and they indicate providers who can share

Step 3 – The Programme is evaluated and

validated for Provider A only and approved for

sharing with other providers Step 4 - The

Programme is added in QBS into the relevant

provider's folder entitled "Use an existing

Programme" Step 5 – Provider B applies via QBS

using the "Use a Shared Programme" Form

Step 6 – Provider B's application to use the programme is validated to use the programme and ownership of the programme transfers to them
